Natural Gas and Damage Prevention Leaders Convene with Legislators

Frankfort, Kentucky (3/6/2014) – The Kentucky Gas Association (KGA) and Kentucky811 (KY811) hosted a joint legislative luncheon at the State Capitol on March 6, 2014. Legislators and leaders from the Commonwealth’s natural gas and damage prevention industry met for two hours to discuss underground facilities damage prevention and Kentucky’s natural gas; a clean, efficient, and abundant domestic energy source.

Luncheon representatives spoke on the energy related legislation that is currently active in Session, and KGA supplied attendees with flyers of support for the following bills;
