Ability to Export Reports to Email, Excel, PDF, and Print;
Digital Wallet Cards Available to Operators and/or Contractors;
Ability to View Qualifications in Real Time from any Smart-Phone or Tablet;
Email Reminders of Upcoming Qualification Expirations (30, 60, 90 day, etc.);
Ability to Assign & Track Employees by Company Identified Roles (Line Locator, Meter Reader, Service Tech, etc.);
Access to Archived Transcripts;
Evaluators may Upload Evaluations Directly Into the Online System;
Complete the Evaluation Procedure Check List on Tablets or Complete the Paper Evaluation Procedure List and Upload Data to Online System;
Auto Course Reassignment for Expiring Tasks; and
Multiple Levels of Admin Control to Assignments.
